





MIRACLE OF LOVE

Jesus said, "For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink!" These are strong words from Jesus that scandalized and shocked the Jews. They guarreled among themselves and asked, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus did not change His words. He said, "Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you *do not have life within vou!*" He reveals God's extravagant love by dying on the Cross. He pays the price for our salvation. This is the gift of Himself. Jesus is the greatest gift of the Father to us because God knows that He alone can satisfy us. We are always hungry and thirsty. We are lost, wounded and broken. We are never satisfied with the things in this world. Man does not live on bread alone but by the Words that come from the mouth of God. There is much more to life than merely satisfying physical hunger. St. Augustine said that our hearts are restless until they find rest in you. Lord, you created us only for you. That is why God sent Jesus to the world so that all things might be restored to God. When we eat His flesh, we are never hungry. This is the only way to be totally free and fully alive. Jesus as the bread of life is the miracle of love giving His all and loving to the end so that we become broken bread to others. The miracle of love requires the grace of faith from the Holy Spirit so that we are able to find God in all things and all things in God. This is the power of faith. It empowers us to choose

Donations may be dropped off at the Parish Office.







Children's Liturgy will resume on Sunday September 1, 2024 Liturgy of the Word with Children is... Shared during the 11:00 Sunday Mass.

- The purpose of the Children's Liturgy of the Word is to enrich our children's liturgical experience of God's presence in the ritual proclamation of the Word
- Before the Scripture readings begin, the children ages 4-10 will be called forward, sent with a blessing to room 1 in our Parish Center. The room is set up for the children to continue the liturgical celebration.
- Children will be hearing the same Scripture reading as those in church, broken open and explained by a trained children's liturgy leader in a manner that encourages the children's growth, understanding and Love of God.
- The children are not attending Sunday school at this time. The take-home materials are for family follow-up, encouraging communication about the Gospel reading heard by all members in attendance, allowing them to consider together how to practice the message in life.
