





### FROM THE DESK OF FATHER ROMEO VELOS

YEAR OF LOVE

As we celebrate the birth of our Savior, we are reminded that the reason of the season is Jesus because He is the source of lasting joy, steadfast love, profound peace and infinite mercy. The whole purpose of His birth is to bring freedom, justice, truth and salvation to us not only in the future but here and now. He restores wholeness to our fallen world and brings healing to our wounded humanity. He is the perfect image of God's love. He said, "There is no greater love than this: laying one's life for one's friends" (John 15:13). He fulfilled that on the Cross. As we welcome the New Year 2025, we are called to embrace four important messages that will guide us in this new journey. They are the power of faith, the joy of the coming of Christ, the importance of community and the transformative power of the Holy Spirit. The power of faith is revealed in the life of the Blessed Virgin Mary. She is a great figure of faith. Elizabeth said, Blessed are you who believed that was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled" (Luke 1:45). The annunciation to Mary by Archangel Gabriel happens in her home at Nazareth and she believed. Instead, the annunciation to Zechariah happens in the temple and he doubted. That is why, he became mute. Mary believed because she shows a receptive and believing heart. John the Baptist, Elizabeth, Mary and all the saints were filled with the Holy Spirit and their lives were never the same again. The Holy Spirit is the agent of transformation empowering us to love the way God loves and to live fearless lives. As we welcome the new year, we are called to learn to be humble and obedient like Mary and Jesus and to give birth to Jesus in our hearts. Happy New Year!



# UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA

In re The Roman Catholic Bishop of San Diego Case No. 24-02202

Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: FEBRUARY 3, 2025 YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SAN DIEGO

On June 17, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of San Diego, sometimes referred to as The Diocese of San Diego ("Debtor") filed for protection under chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with Debtor, you must file a claim so as to be received by February 3, 2025, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Debtor. Even if you have already filed a lawsuit against Debtor alleging abuse you must still file a claim to maintain and/or preserve your rights. Claims based on acts or omissions of the Debtor that occurred before June 17, 2024, must be filed on or before February 3, 2025, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before June 17, 2024.
