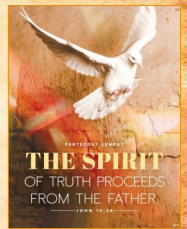

ASCENSION

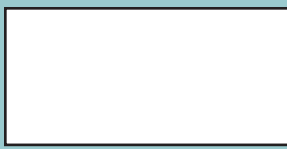




